# 2022 General Election

**February 2022**

Survey conducted February 2 through February 3, 2022. 1,206 likely 2022 General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2022 General Election. Margin of Error is +/-2.8% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Scout.

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Q1: Do you approve or disapprove of Joe Biden's job performance as President?

Approve: 35%  
Disapprove: 60%  
Not sure: 5%

Q2: How closely are you following the congressional redistricting process in Missouri?

Very closely: 17%  
Somewhat closely: 20%  
Not at all: 63%

Q3: Do you think school districts should be allowed to require students to wear masks?

Yes, they should be allowed: 37%  
No, they should not be allowed: 53%  
Not sure: 10%

Q4: There is a proposal to amend the Missouri Constitution to remove state prohibitions on purchasing, possessing, consuming, using, delivering, manufacturing, and selling marijuana for personal use for adults over the age of twenty-one. Do you support or oppose this proposal?

Support: 40%  
Oppose: 43%  
Not sure: 17%

Q5: There is a proposal to amend the Missouri Constitution to allow any entity licensed by the Missouri Gaming Commission to offer sports betting, subject to a 10 percent tax with half going to pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade education, and half going to highways, roads and bridges. Do you support or oppose this proposal?

Support: 46%  
Oppose: 37%  
Not sure: 17%
