

## February 2021

#### Missouri Statewide 2022 General Election

Survey conducted February 24 through February 25, 2021. 1,051 likely 2022 General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2022 General Election. Margin of Error is +/-3% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Scout.










