Public Opinion

Survey conducted November 15 through November 16, 2018. 1,460 likely 2020 General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2020 General Election. Margin of Error is +/-2.6%. Margins of Error within specific demographics (crosstabs) is significantly higher due to smaller sample size.
Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.
