

**MISSOURI  
STATEWIDE  
REPUBLICAN PRIMARY  
2016**

Survey conducted May 13 through May 14, 2016. 1,421 likely Republican primary voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2016 Republican Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-2.7% with a 95% level of confidence. Margins of Error within specific demographics (crosstabs) is significantly higher due to smaller sample size. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

**Q:** The candidates in the Republican primary election for Missouri Governor are Catherine Hanaway, Peter Kinder, John Brunner and Eric Greitens. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Peter Kinder: 26%  
John Brunner: 20%  
Catherine Hanaway: 12%  
Eric Greitens: 7%  
Undecided: 34%

**Q:** The candidates in the Republican primary election for Missouri Lieutenant Governor are Mike Parson and Bev Randles. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Mike Parson: 25%  
Bev Randles: 16%  
Undecided: 59%

John R. Ashcroft: 52%
