House leadership - In two and half weeks, facing head winds from US Senate candidates, the Senate's Conservative Caucus and Secretary of State Jay Ashcroft, House leadership put their heads down and passed the congressional map.

MO Dem legislators – As the 7-1 vs 6-2 fight gets ugly, Dems grab the popcorn and cozy seat to watch Republicans devolve into name calling: RINO this, RINO that.
