Question:

Now let me read you a brief description of the two candidates running in the 2022 Democratic Primary Election for St. Louis County Executive.

Democrat Sam Page is a medical doctor. As county executive, he has showed the leadership and unique skills to lead our County during the coronavirus pandemic. Page has made public safety a priority, has enacted policies to protect victims of domestic violence, and secured federal funding for treatment and prevention programs to combat the opioid crisis. Page has been criticized for instituting a county-wide mask mandate and for his opposition to attempts by the county council to exercise greater oversight of his office and staff.

Democrat Jane Dueker is an attorney and lobbyist for the police unions in St. Louis County and the City of St. Louis. Dueker is a former assistant attorney general and the first female chief of staff for a Missouri governor helping to administer a twenty-four-billion-dollar budget. Dueker says her focus will be on crime and public safety and believes she has the experience to lead St. Louis County. Dueker has been criticized for her role as a top advisor to disgraced former county executive Steve Stenger, who went to jail for corruption, and for her opposition to policies aimed at reducing police misconduct and brutality.
